Key Sounds

	ch j ñ ll rr
ñ	In castañuelas (castanets)
rr	In guitarra (guitar)
Stress placement	For words that end in a vowel or 'n' and 's' it is normally the second to last syllable like <i>trom-pe-ta</i> and <i>gui-ta-rra</i> .
accents	Accents can only be written over vowels in Spanish and indicate the vowel is stressed – regardless of the other rules! As seen in <i>trián-gu-lo</i> & <i>ba-te-rí-a</i> .
