

gamelan	A traditional group of tuned percussion instruments from Indonesia.
beater	The stick to strike the glockenspiel/xylophone.
minim	A two beat note.
crotchet	A one beat note.
stave	Five lines for the music to sit on.
pulse	A steady beat.
pitch	How high or low notes are.
rest	A pause in the music, a short silent section.
accompaniment	Music that goes with a song.





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
