I cannot believe that the year 6 pupils will be leaving Grange Park in just 4 weeks! See below the exciting plans we have in place for the pupils.

## **Year 6 Performance**

The children have been busy practising their Year 6 Performance 'The Lion King.' I'm pleased to say that **one parent** for each child is invited to come along and watch the children perform. Please see dates and times to choose from:

- Monday 19 July 9:30am & 2:00pm
- Tuesday 20 July 9:30am & 2:00pm

The performance will last approximately 1.5 hours. A parentmail will be sent out later on this week for one parent for each child to select the performance they would like to come and see. Please see below information which states the additional measures we are putting in place in line with our COVID risk assessment:

- Parents should enter the school grounds at 9:15am (for the 9:30am performance) and 1:45pm (for the 2:00pm performance). Parents dropping off younger siblings in the morning should drop off and leave the school site before re-entering at 9:15am. Parents can start walking towards the Year 5&6 Hub at 9:15am and 1:45pm and enter the building via the Y5&6 double doors to make their way to the main hall.
- A staff member will be waiting for parents by the main hall, ticking off whoever is on the list and showing each parent to their seat.
- We are required to keep a record of all parents entering the school, therefore parents will be required to use the NHS Test and Trace App to 'check in' (a NHS QR code poster will be displayed).
- Parents will be required to wear face coverings in the main hall unless they are exempt.
- The audience will be socially distanced from each other and the performers. The main hall doors will be kept open to provide ventilation.

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I know that these timings and arrangements may not be ideal for parents, but I'm sure you can appreciate the measures we have to put in place in order to meet legal requirements and make the event as safe as we can. Please ensure that the above measures are followed. The performance will also be recorded and will be shared with all parents.
