

Dear Parents

Year 3 have planned an exciting visit to central London as part of our Learning Quest 'Tomb Raiders'. The purpose of the visit will be for the children to investigate artifacts and examine the beliefs of the ancient Egyptians, it will also include an exciting workshop hosted by the museum focussing on Ancient Egyptian life.

All Year 3 classes (ash, Cedar and Willow) will be going on the trip on Thursday 23 June.

We will be travelling by tube. Please drop your child off **at Oakwood station at 9.15 am**, where they will meet their teacher, before being registered and organised into the appropriate classes for the day. Pupils who attend breakfast club in the morning will be dropped off at Oakwood station via the mini bus. **Pupils will return to school at 3.00 pm** in time for a normal pick up at the end of the school day.

The cost of this trip is £3 which will cover expenses for the lunch hall accommodation and the workshop on Egyptian Life. In accordance with the 1996 Education Act we have to ask for a 'voluntary contribution' towards the cost of the trip. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered, the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium or Free School Meals the school can support you. 'Voluntary contributions' should be paid via ParentMail > Payment Item > Shop > Y3 Visit to the British Museum. Please ensure that your contribution is paid by 12.00 pm on Friday 17 June latest.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch on this day (no nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). If your child is eligible for Free School Meals then the school can provide a packed lunch. Please indicate below by **12.00 pm on Wednesday 15 June** whether your child will require a school packed lunch.

Your child should wear a school uniform and ensure they have a school bag, a rain-proof coat and comfortable shoes.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on Parentmail by 12.00 pm on Wednesday 15 June and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted.

All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.
