

Heitor Villa Lobos (1887-1959)



Heitor Villa Lobos, on of the most famous Brazilian composers of all time, composed about 2000 pieces of music!

He composed The Little Train of the Caipira in 1930. It is about a steam train chugging and clattering through the countryside of Brazil. Listen out for clarinets, trombones and ratchets which make the sound of the train.

Key Vocabulary	
percussion	An instrument that can be hit, scraped or shaken to make a sound.
body percussion	Make sounds by tapping different parts of the body.
rhythm	A pattern of beats.
sequence	Playing in a set order.
tempo	Going faster or slower. The speed of the beat.
crescendo	Getting louder.
diminuendo	Getting quieter.
ratchet	A wooden instrument with a handle that spins and makes a loud rattling sound.
composer	A person who writes music.
