### **The Natural History Museum**

Year 6 have planned an exciting visit to **The Natural History Museum** as part of our topics on **Mountains and Volcanoes** in Geography. The purpose of the visit will be to gain a better understanding of this topic and gain knowledge in how volcanoes are formed and the impact of eruptions.

Kandinsky and Monet will be visiting on **Monday 6 June**.  
Picasso and Lowry will be visiting on **Tuesday 7 June**.

We will be travelling by coach. The Children should come to school at 8.45 in the morning. They will return at approximately 3.10 pm.

The cost of this trip is £16.50 which will cover the workshop provided as well as the coaches needed to transport classes. In accordance with the 1996 Education Act, we have to ask for 'voluntary contribution' towards the cost of the trip. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium or has Free School Meals the school can support you. 'Voluntary contributions' should be paid via ParentMail > Payment Item > Shop > Y6 Trip to The Natural History Museum by **12.00 pm on Friday 20 May**.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day (no nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please), however if your child is receiving free school meals then the school can provide a packed lunch. Please indicate below whether your child will require a school lunch.

Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a coat in case of rain for the transitions on and off the coaches.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on Parentmail by **12.00 pm on Friday 20 May** and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted.

**All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.**
