Dear parents

RE: Sports Day Arrangements

We are pleased to inform you of the final arrangements for the school sports days this year. The sports coaches have worked hard to plan the sessions allowing all children to take part in a carousel of activities, which we hope the children will enjoy. The weather forecast for next week appears to be favourable but we will let you know as soon as we can if we need to rearrange the events. All events take place on the school field.

How to enter the school	Drop your child off as usual and make your way to the field from 9am (through the playgrounds). *Please be on the field in plenty of time before the activities start.			

Please ensure that your child:

- Wears their PE uniform on this day
- Your child should not bring their chromebook into school this day
- Brings a bottle of water with their name on it
- Brings a cap or hat to protect them should the weather be sunny
- If the weather is sunny, sunscreen should be applied to your child at home in the morning (children can bring in sunscreen that they **can apply themselves** at school if required. This should also be labelled with their name on it).

Nursery parents

- Sports day will be for all children in the nursery Tuesday 20 June from **9:15am- 10:15am**.
- **Children who attend afternoon nursery only:** Please can the nursery children who usually attend the afternoon session be dropped off to the nursery class at 8:50am so they can take part in sports day with the rest of the class. Parents can then take their child home after sports day (directly from the field area) and the children can return back to nursery at 12:30pm for their usual afternoon session.

In order to ensure children are appropriately safeguarded we ask all parents to support us by following these guidelines:

- Children's toilets are for **Grange Park pupils only** and should not be used by parents or any child accompanying them on the day. There will be a member of staff available at the door into the main building on the bottom playground to direct you to the nearest adult toilet (in the Year 3 corridor).
- If you arrive later, please enter via the path next to the Y5&Y6 Hub (this will be signposted) where a member of staff will direct where you need to go.
- If you need to leave earlier please let an adult know as you will need to be escorted off the premises via the path next to the Y5&6 Hub.
- Parents to keep behind the 'respect barrier' at all times.
- There will be enough staff to deal with any issues the children may have- so please leave it to them!
- Please remember that any photos or videos taken on the day are for your personal use only and shouldn't be shared on social media.
- Cheering is welcome, but remember to keep it nice and friendly. The aim of the day is for the children to have lots of fun!
