### **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre, St Albans**

In the Spring term, Year 4 have planned an exciting visit to **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre, St Albans** as part of our topic about the 'Rampaging Romans' in history. The purpose of the visit will be to gain a better understanding of what life was like in Ancient Rome, to explore artefacts and learn about how they were uncovered by archeologists for us to study.

Year 4 classes will be visiting **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre** on:

**6 March:** Puma and Leopard

**7 March:** Jaguar and Tiger

We will be travelling to the museum by coach. The children will be travelling by coach and will return to school in time for a normal pick up at the end of the school day. In the event that we are late back to school, we ask for and appreciate your patience in advance.

The cost of this trip is **£16.50** which will cover the tours/workshops provided as well as the coaches needed to transport classes. In accordance with the 1996 Education Act, we have to ask for 'voluntary contribution' towards the cost of the trip. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium or has Free School Meals the school can support you. Voluntary contributions to be paid via ParentMail > Payment Item > Shop > **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre** by **1 March 2024** at the latest.

Your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals so the school can provide a packed lunch which will consist of a cheese sandwich, a piece of fruit and vegetable sticks or you can provide your own packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag (not nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Please indicate whether your child will require a school packed lunch by **15 February 2024**

*Please do not order lunch for your child if you are going to send your own packed lunch.*

Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat and appropriate footwear.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on ParentMail and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted. Parents accompanying the trip are advised to take a lateral flow test before the trip.

**All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.**
