National Gallery

Year 2 have planned an exciting visit to the National Gallery in Trafalgar Square as part of our learning quest topic: Mad for Madagascar. Your child's class teacher will meet you at Oakwood station at 9.15am for registration and a prompt departure. We will return to Oakwood station at 3.10pm where you will need to collect your child from. Please drop off and collect your child from Oakwood station (not school) on the day of the trip. If your child usually attends breakfast club in the morning, they will be taken to Oakwood on the minibus. If they are in Extend after school or an enrichment club, they will be dropped off to the school on minibus

The cost of this trip is **FREE**. Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a suitable coat and footwear.

Your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals so the school can provide a packed lunch which will consist of a cheese sandwich, a piece of fruit and vegetable sticks or you can provide your own packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag (no nuts -including spreads such as peanut butter and Nutella).
