#### ABBA

ABBA are a Swedish pop group formed in Stockholm in 1972 by Agnetha Fältskog, Björn Ulvaeus, Benny Andersson, and Anni-Frid Lyngstad. The group's name is an acronym of the first letters of their first names , A -B- B -A arranged as a palindrome (a word which reads the same forwards as backwards)

#### Success

One of the most popular and successful musical groups of all time, they became one of the best-selling music acts in the history of popular music, topping the charts worldwide from 1974 to



1983, and again in 2021. ABBA have achieved 48 hit singles.

#### Instruments

Benny plays the keyboard and Bjorn plays the electric guitar. Anna and Agneta are the lead singers but Benny and Bjorn also sing on many of their songs.
