Woodcroft Wildspace

Year 3 have planned an exciting visit to Woodcroft Wildspace as part of our Science topic about plants. The purpose of the visit will be to look at, sort and classify different types of plants and to further our knowledge of the function of each part of a plant. We will also be looking closely at how the change of seasons affects the natural world.

Willow will be visiting Woodcroft on Friday 27 September 2024. **Ash** will be visiting Woodcroft on Tuesday 1 October 2024. **Oak** will be visiting Woodcroft on Friday 4 October 2024.

All classes (on the day of their visit) will be walking to the site. All children should come to school promptly at the usual time of 8:45 in the morning as we will be leaving shortly after this and will return at 12.45pm in time for a normal school lunch.

The cost of this trip is £3 which will cover the workshop at the venue. No additional spending money is permitted. In accordance with the 1996 Education Act, we have to ask for 'voluntary contribution' towards the cost of the trip. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the trip will be cancelled.

Your child should wear a school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat, suitable for possible rainy conditions. At times, Woodcroft can become **<u>quite muddy</u>** so it is advisable that your child has **<u>suitable footwear</u>** in the event that this is the case.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on the <u>google form</u> and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted. Please ensure that your voluntary contribution is paid by Wednesday 25 September 2024 at the latest.

All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.
