### **Enfield Music Service (EMS) lessons starting Spring 2025**

Dear Parents,

Enfield Music Service (EMS) are now taking new subscriptions for instrument lessons in school for the spring term. If you wish your child to start individual or paired/group lessons, please either continue to pay via the website or create a new account. More details for new customers are below.

There will be 9 lessons in the spring term beginning the week commencing 13 January 2025.

We currently have piano, keyboard, violin, guitar, ukulele, drums, woodwind and brass tutors delivering weekly lessons. **Year 4** are currently learning clarinet as part of their weekly music lessons so if your child would like to continue to further their skills, the woodwind teacher is available for individual or group lessons - the latter is ideal for friends in the same class as they will be at the same level to progress to the next step. Instruments can be hired from EMS under the **store** tab on the website below.

**The deadline for booking lessons starting in January is Sunday 1 December.** Please use the following website where you will find all the prices by clicking on **store**. There is also information in the **store** about Saturday ensembles if you prefer your child to learn at the weekend.
