Dear Parents

Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre, St Albans

In the Spring term, Year 4 have planned an exciting visit to **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre, St Albans** as part of our topic about the 'Rampaging Romans' in history. The purpose of the visit will be to gain a better understanding of what life was like in Ancient Rome, to explore artefacts and learn about how they were uncovered by archeologists for us to study.

Year 4 classes will be visiting **Verulamium Museum and Roman Theatre** on:

Thursday 13 March: Leopard and Tiger

Friday 14 March: Puma and Jaguar

We will be travelling to the museum by coach. The children will be travelling by coach and will return to school in time for a normal pick up at the end of the school day. In the event that we are late back to school, we ask for and appreciate your patience in advance.

The cost of this trip is £25.00 which will cover the tours/workshops provided as well as the coaches needed to transport classes. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium the school can support you. Contributions to be paid via Arbor > School Trips > Y4 Verulamium Museum by **7 March 2024** at the latest.

Your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals so The Pantry can provide a packed lunch which will need to be ordered on The Pantry website. Please follow these instructions:

1. *Log into your Pantry account.*
2. *On the dashboard click on view, under the name of the trip and the required meal.*
3. *Under upcoming events, click on details to select the required meal.*
4. *Once you have selected the required meal click on the green book button.*
5. *You then need to click on the tick box to give consent, then click the green confirm order button.*
6. *The packed lunch is now booked; you can view, amend or cancel the order by clicking on the details button.*
7. *Please remember to cancel your main hot meal if you have booked one.*
8. *Please ensure that your child brings a bottle of water with them for the trip.*
9. *ALL lunches to be ordered via The Pantry by **4pm on Friday 7 March** as the ordering system will be closed after this date*

Please do not order a school packed lunch if you are going to send your own packed lunch.

Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat and appropriate footwear.
