### Learning Conversations Autumn 2024

We are excited to invite you into the school for learning conversations on **Thursday 24 October: 1.30 - 7.00pm** for reception - Year 6. **Please note this is a regular school day for the children.**

Parents will be asked to select an allotted ten minute slot at the time most convenient for them, according to the slots available, which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. **Slots will be available to book via Arbor from 6pm Monday 30 September until 9am Monday 21 October 2024.** Each parent can book one 10 minute session to speak with the child's teacher, to hear how they are getting on, and ask any questions. During the conversation, your child's teacher will discuss how your child has settled into new routines at school and how well they have engaged with learning so far. If your child has a learning support plan, this will also be discussed. Out of courtesy to other parents, please keep to the time set.

Members of the headship team will be available to speak to parents, you will need to make contact via the office separately and book an appointment.

If you book an appointment during the school day, please arrive ten minutes before your first appointment and enter through the main office doors. You should collect a visitors badge from the office and go straight to the classroom to collect your child and their books before proceeding to the appropriate venue. Once you have completed the learning conversation you may take your child home with you (please sign them out on the register list in the school office) or send them back to class. Parents booking appointments after 3:25pm should go straight to the appropriate venue.
