Dates for the clubs

For the autumn term, all clubs will commence the week beginning **16 September 2024** until week ending **13 December 2024** (excluding half term and inset days and learning conversations). The clubs will begin straight after school at **3:25pm and finish** at **4:30pm**. Children should be collected in the designated meeting area near the school gates from the adult who runs the club. The 'Autumn Showcase' will take place during the week ending 13 December 2024.

Cost for clubs

The charge is **£5.50** per child per session, therefore the cost of each club for the autumn term will be **£66.00** (for **12 weeks**). The clubs on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays will be **£60.50** as we have learning conversations Thursday 24 October and two inset days on Monday 4 November and Friday 29 November 2024. If your child is **Pupil Premium**, then the school will fund your child's place at **one** club throughout the year. This reasonable charge is intended to fund resources required for these activities and also contribute to investing in the school in a variety of ways.

If you are in receipt of tax free childcare vouchers, payment can be made to the school via the childcare voucher provider. When the payment is received by the school we will manually credit the payment item on Arbor. To find out if you are eligible or for more information, click here.

Booking a club via Arbor

Clubs will be available to book and pay for, via a payment item on **ARBOR**, from **7.00pm on Tuesday 16 July 2024**. You will need to ensure that you have registered for Arbor before 7pm on Tuesday 16 July so that you can secure your place. If you are having any difficulties registering with Arbor please contact the school office who will try and help you.

Once the clubs are available to book please select 'Clubs' from the dashboard or quick actions. You will see all the available clubs for your child. Select which club you would like to enrol your child in and press the green button at the top 'Register for this club' which will enable you to make payment. This will secure your child's place in the club. If you cannot see the club there are no more spaces available.

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Please do not book your child a place in the club unless you are sure that they want to partake, as booking unwanted places may prevent another child from being successful in joining the club. Also please ensure that you book the club for the correct year group bearing in mind that your child will go up to the next year in September, e.g. Year 2 children should book clubs which are for Year 3. **We are unable to offer refunds should the club be booked in error.** Once the club is full, you will no longer be able to view the payment on Arbor, so in that case, please email the school office, in order for your child to be added to the waiting list. Once payment has been made your child's place in the club is secured.

External clubs

Externally run clubs should be booked directly through the provider using the details provided above. These clubs will begin straight after school at 3:25pm and finish at 4:30pm (unless otherwise stated). Children should be collected in the meeting area by the school gates from the adult who runs the club.

We hope to see your child in the enrichment clubs next term!
